¹ Pursuant to Section 33 (18) 8 Federal Roads Toll Act (BStMG), motor vehicles with a maximum permissible weight (MPW) of no more than 3.5 tonnes that were registered before 01.12.2023 and for which the maximum permissible weight (MPW) was set at no more than 3.5 tonnes before 01.12.2023 are deemed to be vehicles with a maximum technically permissible laden mass of no more than 3.5 tonnes until 31.01.2029 and are, therefore, subject to the time-based toll.
