

## TOLLING REGULATIONS INFORMATION SHEET

### Changes in Version 68 Compared to Version 67

With this information sheet, we are giving an overview of the main changes to the Tolling Regulations in Version 68, compared to Version 67.

#### **Temporary toll exemption for motor vehicles with a Ukrainian license plate number**

For humanitarian reasons, due to the armed conflict in Ukraine, in consultation with the Federal Ministry for Climate Action, Environment, Energy, Mobility, Innovation and Technology and the Federal Ministry of Finance, all motor vehicles with a Ukrainian license plate number are exempt from the obligation to pay toll.

For vehicles with a maximum GVW of up to 3,5 t, the relevant passages have been amended in Part A I, section 1.3.3.2.2 concerning the mandatory vignette as well as in Part A II, section 2.3.2.1 concerning the section toll.

For vehicles with a maximum GVW of more than 3,5 t, the corresponding passage is to be found in Part B, section 3.3.2.1.

For now, the toll exemption is valid until 30 June 2022.

#### **Toll exemption for humanitarian aid transports and for the transport of displaced persons**

The existing exemption for humanitarian aid transports due to the armed conflict in Ukraine was clarified: The exemption applies to transports of goods and merchandise as well as to the transport of persons who are considered displaced persons within the meaning of the Displaced Persons Ordinance (BGBL. II No. 92/2022).

For vehicles with a maximum GVW of up to 3,5 t, the relevant passages have been amended in Part A I, section 1.3.3.2.2 concerning the mandatory vignette as well as in Part A II, section 2.3.2.1 concerning the section toll.

For vehicles with a maximum GVW of more than 3,5 t, the corresponding passage is to be found in Part B, section 3.3.2.1.

#### **Changes to Appendices 3a – 3c**

Due to the current state of emergency, Appendices 3a to 3c shall be amended.
