

TOLLING REGULATIONS INFORMATION SHEET

Changes in Version 72 compared to Version 71

With this information sheet, we are giving an overview of the main changes to the Tolling Regulations in Version 72, compared to Version 71.

Exemption from the toll obligation for motor vehicles with Ukrainian license plates

In coordination with the Federal Ministry for Climate Protection, Environment, Energy, Mobility, Innovation and Technology and the Federal Ministry of Finance, **the temporary toll exemption for motor vehicles with a maximum permissible weight of up to 3.5 t** with a Ukrainian license plate number will be prolonged due to the current state of emergency because of the armed conflict in Ukraine until **September 30, 2023.**The **temporary toll exemption for motor vehicles with** a Ukrainian license plate and a **maximum permissible weight of more than 3.5 t expires on April 30, 2023.**

Changes to Appendix 2 (Payment Means and Methods)

Additional types of on-board units have been approved for the EETS service.

Additional changes in the Preamble, Parts AI, AII, B and Appendices 3e and 3f

Minor clarifications have been made throughout the text without changing the content of the Tolling Regulations.

- Change in the structure of the chapter "Exceptions for humanitarian aid transports":
 - The clarification that a toll exception will only apply if a specific case within the meaning of § 5 Para. 2 BStMG is announced in the Tolling Regulations (Part A I item 1.3.3.2.2., Part A II item 2.3.2.1, Part B item 3.3.2.1) was placed at the beginning of the chapter.
- Preamble, Appendices 3e and 3f:
 Clarification and standardization of the documents with regard to personal designations
- Extension of the retroactive query option for the itemised toll information in the post-pay procedure to 18 months (previously 12 months)

Provisions for collective invoices in Parts B and C

In Part B, item 5.5.1 "Payment Procedure - General Information", the last paragraph on reprints of collective invoices will be removed as this is already regulated in item 6.2.



Part B, Item 6.2 "Collective Invoice" will be standardized to the effect that collective invoices will be made available for a fee of EUR 5.00 irrespective of the period queried. Additionally, the term "collective invoice statement" is replaced by the term "collective invoice" throughout the Tolling Regulations (Parts B and C).
